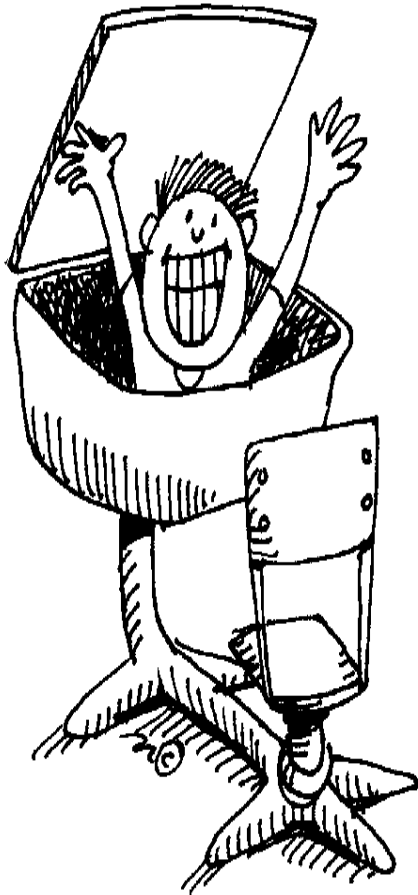


Homework Hub is HERE!
